

SAGUARO NTS NET SCRIPT – Updated: MAY 16, 2017

OPENING:

Good evening everyone. This is <name & call>, your net control for tonight's Saguaro National Traffic System Net. This net meets every night at 6:30 P.M. on the EAARS Repeater Network. This is a directed net. Please pass all communication through net control. Are there any emergency or priority announcements?

Our mission is to train and pass radiogram messages into and out of our coverage area and wherever third-party traffic is permitted, to be ready to serve in an emergency. Radiogram messages may be used for fun, such as to wish someone a happy birthday, or in emergencies to pass critical information. Our website, SaguaroNTS.net, provides reference to common radiograms used on this net and other helpful information.

We are affiliated with the Arizona Traffic and Emergency Net (ATEN), a high-frequency, voice, section net that meets nightly at 7:00 P.M. on 3986 kHz.
